Our Patron of the Month is picked to recognize outstanding patrons at NAPL! Sue is a breast cancer survivor & long time patron, we appreciate you Sue!

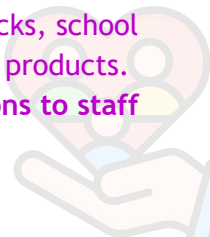


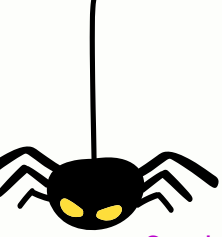
